Large amounts of rain expected over the weekend

A long episode of rain, at times heavy, is expected.



A further 20 to 30 mm of rain is expected to fall through this afternoon over the Peace River and Fort Nelson regions.

The heavy rain is being caused by low pressure centre over central Alberta drifting northwards today. Strong and moist easterly flow associated with the low is generating enhanced precipitation as the flow encounters the eastern slopes of the Rockies. Over the Muncho Lake Park-Stone Mountain Park region the most significant rainfall will be in the Tetsa River region.

The low will weaken somewhat and stall near the AB-BC border this afternoon. The character of the precipitation will become more showery with widespread thunderstorms developing this afternoon over northeastern BC that will persist throughout the evening and into the overnight period. These storms will cause local downpours that will contribute to storm rainfall totals.

Heavy downpours can cause flash floods and water pooling on roads. Watch for possible washouts near rivers, creeks and culverts.


