## Provincial Government Makes Changes to Employment Standards Act

The Provincial government has changed a few employment standards to help better protect children on the job. This all comes after a 10 year evaluation showed that WorkSafeBC paid a total of \$5.2 million in work injury claims to children 15 years and under. Changes were also introduced on Monday to the Employment Standards Act helping prevent workers who are fleeing domestic violence from losing their jobs as well as help to ensure that service workers are entitled to keep their tips.

BC's Labour Minister, Harry Bains, said the amendments are the most significant update to the act in 15 years and address concerns about changes introduced by the former Liberal government in 2003. The amendments will raise the age a child may work from 12 to 16, and also restricts the kind of hazardous work 16 to 18 year olds can be asked to perform.

Bains says "With these changes we are moving the minimum age from 12 years to 16 years, and yes those who are 14, 15 years can work at light duty, which will be described through regulation later,". He also stated at the news conference, "Working people are the lifeblood of this province and yet our employment standards haven't always protected them," saying, "We are the last jurisdiction in Canada, I think, that doesn't comply with international standards when it comes to labour."

The WorkSafeBC report showed that the majority of injury claims paid to children under the age of 15 were to those working in primary resources, construction, manufacturing, transportation, warehousing, trade and the public and service sectors.

The proposed amendments would also protect workers dealing with difficult personal issues and help people receive wages they are owed. The changes include expanded work-leave protections for workers trying to escape domestic violence that allows time from their jobs to find the solutions they need to make life safer for themselves and their kids. The proposed amendments would also provide up to 10 days of unpaid job-protected leaves and allow workers to receive up to 15 weeks of consecutive unpaid leave, Bains says. It would also protect the jobs of workers caring for critically ill family members, providing unpaid leaves of 36 weeks to care for a child and 16 weeks to provide care for an adult.

The amendments would prohibit employers from withholding tips or other gratuities from their workers. Being that these tips are a part of the wages they've earned from providing that service to the customer, this will also prohibit employers from deciding how tips will be distributed.

The B.C. Federation of Labour said in a statement that the changes will improve fairness for workers and bring the province in line with international labour standards. The federation also said it welcomed the increase in the minimum age for formal employment to 16, while allowing light duty work for younger workers.

## Pre-approved versus pre-qualified: what's the difference?

### MORTGAGE PRE-QUALIFICATION

To get pre-qualified for a mortgage, a lender needs to evaluate your financial situation — including your income, assets and debts — to determine how much you can afford to borrow. It can usually be done for no cost, often over the phone or the internet.

The pre-qualification stage allows you to discuss different mortgage options with your lender and get a sense of your price range. However, the pre-qualified amount is just a rough estimate of how much you might be approved for.

### MORTGAGE PRE-APPROVAL

Getting pre-approved for a mortgage is a more involved process. You'll need to fill out an official mortgage application and supply the lender with the necessary information to thoroughly

evaluate your financial history and credit score. This process allows the lender to tell you the mortgage amount for which you'll be approved. You may also be able to lock in an interest rate.

When you get pre-approved, your lender will provide you with a letter explaining the loan you're eligible for. Being pre-approved for a mortgage shows sellers you're a serious contender when making offers.

Keep in mind that even after you've been pre-approved, you're still not guaranteed to receive a loan. Once you've found the house you wish to buy, your lender will need to evaluate you and the property in question before committing to a loan amount and interest rate.
