CATHY NORRIS WILL CUT HAIR FOR CANCER AWARENESS

It might not be the first cut she's had, but for will definitely be the deepest. To commem Society's annual awareness campaign using daffodil pins to raise money for cancer research, she will be chopping off her ponytail to donate it to the cause. She became interested in the idea after her niece, Ashley Norris, cut off and donated 14 inches of her hair in 2014. "Cancer touches everybody," said Norris, "and after losing my mother to the disease I wanted to be able to give back in a meaningful way."

Luckily, her bright white (arctic blonde)

hair is in high demand, providing her a great way to help out people who have lost their hair due to cancer treatments. Norris said it was important to her to donate as "it can be hard for people with physical handicaps who are limited in the ways they can give back," and providing hair for wigs lets her contribute without taking a toll on her body. She knows from personal experience how valuable the gift of donating can be, having received donated bone material a few years ago after suffering a fractured pelvis. The donation process "has really made me think about cancer patients, especially children and teenagers, who deal with hair loss," said Norris, and she hopes that her donated locks can make a difference for someone struggling with their morale.

The ponytail will be taken by Pantene Beautiful Lengths, who work with the Canadian Cancer Society to create wigs out of the donated hair. Since they began working together in July 2014 they have received over 46,000 ponytail donations, and anyone wishing to donate should check out their website for details. Any donated hair cannot be dyed and must be at least 8 inches in length, as it takes between 8-15 ponytails of 8 inch length to make a single wig. The wigs are provided free of charge to anyone undergoing cancer treatment. As for Norris, she will refashioning her hair into a bob-style cut that she hopes isn't too dramatic of a change. "I've had a few moments of anxiety

leading up to it," she said about her impending new 'do, but she knows it will grow back and when it does, "I'll probably donate it again!"

MATT'S MUSINGS



It's not a theme I hope to return to often this year, but once again the world has lost another musical giant. Prince Rogers Nelson, known to the world as simply Prince, died last week at the age of 57, leaving behind a legacy of innovative music (and outfits), one fantastic movie, and a lot of mystery. Despite being one of the biggest stars in the world, particularly in the 1980s, Prince was a remarkably private figure. In addition to having countless unknown hours of unreleased music in his vaults, Prince's public image was also meticulously cared for, which is unfortunately why you can't find much of his work on YouTube. Much of what we know about him personally is often revealed by other people, such as his basketball prowess famously recounted by Charlie Murphy in a legendary Chappelle's Show sketch.

Prince never let us see much of the real him, and yet so many people felt as though they had lost a loved one last week, his music having touched their lives in such a meaningful way. As I sat in Murray's Pub the other night, I overhead a conversation from some older folks who you would never assume to be Prince fans by looking at them, recounting with awe the depths of his talent. He played literally dozens of different instruments but will forever be known as one of the most iconic guitar players of all time. One clip that was passed around a lot last week was his guitar solo during a performance of "While My Guitar Gently Weeps" at the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame with other luminaries like Tom Petty, Jeff Lynne and Steve Winwood. Prince's effortless solo makes Eric Clapton's original seem mild-mannered (Clapton famously once said "ask Prince" when asked what it felt like to be the world's greatest guitar player), and then in a fitting metaphor for his passing, he removes his guitar, tosses it into the audience, and calmly walks off-stage as if nothing had happened despite blowing everyone's minds.

He was one of the most complicated superstars to ever grace this planet, starting his career with provocative, highly sexual music before becoming a devoutly religious man who would kick celebrities out of his mansion for swearing. Who else could have written songs that shocked Al Gore's wife Tipper to the point of creating the Parents Music Research Council (he's the reason we have explicit lyrics warnings on album covers) in addition to becoming a staunch Jehovah's Witness who regularly attended meetings as "Brother Nelson" and would go door-to-door to proselytize? He could play every instrument on his lush, expansive albums and captivate stadiums with nothing more than a piano and his voice, as he did on his final tour. Although he was tiny, he contained multitudes.

Prince, Michael Jackson and Madonna are thought of as the Big 3 of the 1980s but Prince stood alone in the way he influenced the sound of that decade. People may have dressed more like Madonna or Michael Jackson, but the music on the radio, no matter the station, often featured the unmistakable electronic drum sounds that Prince popularized. By the end of the decade even indie, "alternative" bands were experimenting with electronic drum kits to varying degrees of success. Some of that music sounds incredibly dated today but it's hard to express how revolutionary it sounded at the time. Innovators will always spawn imitators, but few were able to craft music as timeless as Prince, with songs that stirred up so many emotions in people because they could feel the passion of the man who created it pouring out, like a Purple Rain.


