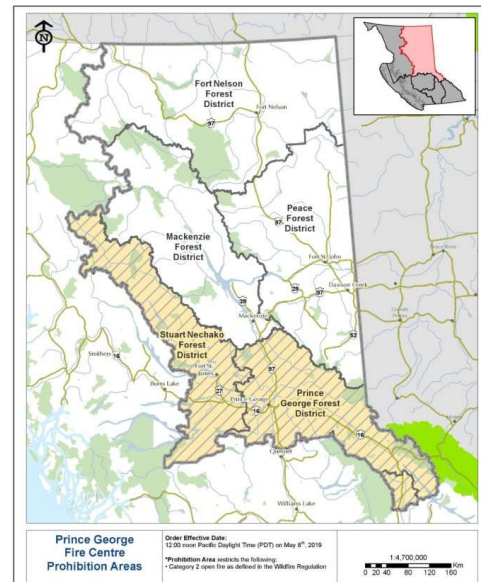

Effective noon tomorrow, category 2 open fires will be prohibited within the Prince George Fire Centre due to dry and hot conditions in the forecast. Category 2 fires include the open burning of any material piled or unpiled smaller than 2 metres high and 3 metres wide and stubble or grass fires over an area smaller than 2,000 square metres. In Chetwynd category 2 Burning Permits will also be canceled, however, camp fires will be permitted.

**OXEYE DAISY**  
(*Leucanthemum vulgare*)

#### DESCRIPTION:

This perennial grows up to 1m tall with one single 2–5cm diameter flower with white petals and a yellow centre; lower leaves are spoon shaped and stalked; upper leaves are stalkless and narrower.

#### PREVENTION:

- Manage pastures to maintain healthy plant communities.
- Clean footwear, clothing, equipment, and tires after recreating or working in infested areas.
- **MOW** before the plant goes to flower.
- **PURCHASE** weed free hay, soil, seed mixes, and gravel.



Daisies such as **Oxeye Daisy** and **Scentless Chamomile** are plagues to the Peace River Regional District.

These daisies are not native wildflowers in BC, they are **invasive plants**.



**SCENTLESS CHAMOMILE**  
(*Matricaria perforata*)

#### DESCRIPTION:

This annual or short-lived perennial grows up to 1m tall with multiple flowers, branched, glossy, fern-like leaves that alternate along the branched stem; seeds are viable once the flower is visible and are carried by wind, water, and animals.

#### PREVENTION:

- Clean equipment when working in infestations.
- **MOW** before plant goes to flower
- **PURCHASE** weed free hay, soil, seed mixes, and gravel.

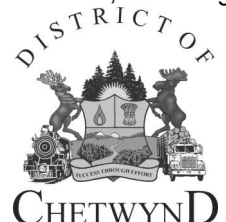

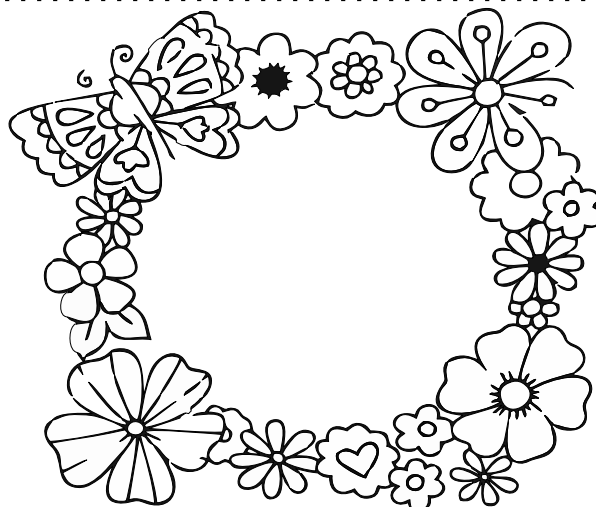

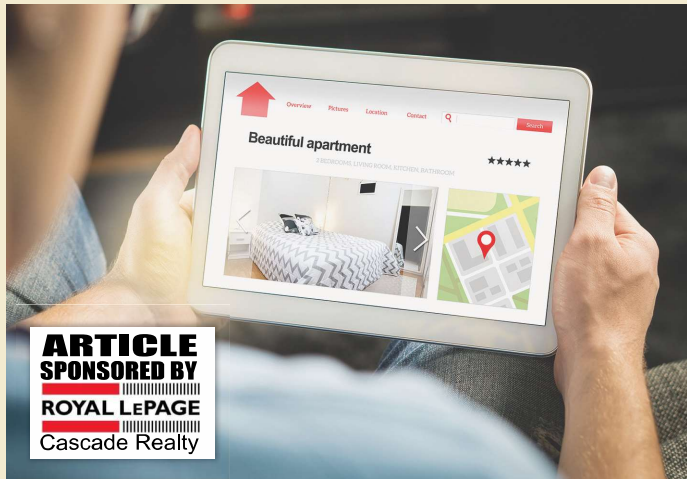
## Make sure your short-term rental unit is legal

These days, many people rent out their homes through companies like Airbnb and VRBO. While this can be a good way to make some extra money, it's essential to make sure you don't violate any laws or regulations.

If you're a renter, you'll need to check with your landlord before renting out your home on a short-term basis. Your lease may prohibit you from subletting. If you violate the terms of your lease, your landlord will have grounds to evict you. If your landlord agrees to let you provide short-term rentals, be sure to get this agreement in writing.

If you're a homeowner who belongs to a homeowners' association (HOA), it may be against the HOA's rules to use your home for short-term rentals.

## Mexican STRAWBERRY WATER (Agua de Fresa)

### Ingredients

4 cups strawberries, sliced  
1 cup white sugar

8 cups cold water  
1 lime, cut into 8 wedges (optional)  
8 fresh mint sprigs (optional)

In a medium bowl, mix together sliced strawberries, sugar, and 1 cup of water. Cover the bowl with plastic wrap and place in the refrigerator for 4 hours.

Add the remaining 7 cups cold water to the pureed strawberries and mix well. Place the Agua de Fresa in the refrigerator to chill for several hours or pour over ice and serve immediately. Garnish with lime slices or mint leaves.

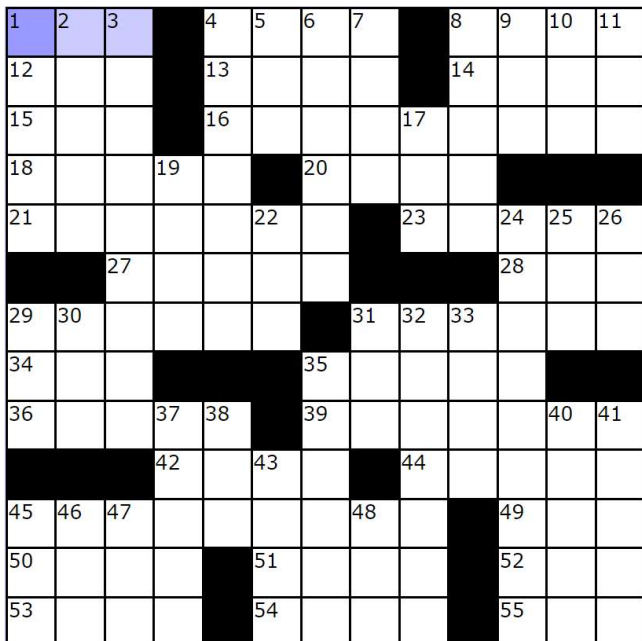
