


DESCRIPTION:

This perennial grows up to 1m tall with one single 2–5cm diameter flower with white petals and a yellow centre; lower leaves are spoon shaped and stalked; upper leaves are stalkless and narrower.

PREVENTION:

- Manage pastures to maintain healthy plant communities.
- Clean footwear, clothing, equipment, and tires after recreating or working in infested areas.
- MOW before the plant goes to flower.
- PURCHASEweed free hay, soil, seed mixes, and gravel.

These daisies are not native wildflowers in BC, they are invasive plants.



DESCRIPTION:

This annual or short-lived perennial grows up to 1m tall with multiple flowers, branched, glossy, fernlike leaves that alternate along the branched stem; seeds are viable once the flower is visible and are carried by wind, water, and animals.

PREVENTION:

- Clean equipment when working in infestations.
- MOW before plant goes to flower
- PURCHASEweed free hay, soil, seed mixes, and gravel.



If you're a homeowner who belongs to a homeowners' association (HOA), it may be against the HOA's rules to use your home for short-term rentals.

You also need to carefully research zone and land-use laws in your area before renting out your home. In many cities and towns, short-term rental hosting is restricted or prohibited. 4 cups strawberries, sliced 1 cup white sugar

8 cups cold water

1 lime, cut into 8 wedges (optional) 8 fresh mint sprigs (optional)

Prep 25 m Ready In 4 h 25 m

In a medium bowl, mix together sliced strawberries, sugar, and 1 cup of water. Cover the bowl with plastic wrap and place in the refrigerator for 4 hours.

Remove the strawberry mixture from the refrigerator and pour into a blender. Blend on high until smooth. Pour the blended berry mixture through a wire mesh strainer set over a large mixing bowl; discard the pulp and seeds.



Add the remaining 7 cups cold water to the pureed strawberries and mix well. Place the Aqua de Fresa in the refrigerator to chill for several hours or pour over ice and serve immediately. Garnish with lime slices or mint leaves.
