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## COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 14TH

The first regular Council Meeting of 2019 was held this past Monday, January 14th, in the council chambers. Everyone was in attendance with the exception of Councillor Dishar.

The meeting began with a presentation from Jaidan Ward with an update from the Community Paramedic BC Emergency Health Services. He started his presentation explaining that they are helping to stabilize paramedic staffing in rural and remote communities to bridge the gaps identified by local primary care teams. They help with home care, education on prescriptions and post appointment information. The majority of their patients are older people living on their own. These patients are living with chronic conditions like heart failure, COPD and diabetes, also those who are at risk of falls, they help to determine hazards. Patients have to be referred by their physician or primary care provider to be eligible for these services. Jaidan mentioned that these services are available in 26 northern communities and help employ over 30 emergency service paramedics in our area alone. Jaidan mentioned that each month they set up at Pharmasave to help get the info out about their services and also provide vitals checks. If you feel you, or someone you know would benefit from their services contact your health care provider to be assessed and possibly referred.

The next item on the agenda was the deciding on attendance to the "Local Government Leadership Academy seminar in Prince George, as well as the Mineral Exploration Roundup, and the Mayor's round table.

Next the floor was opened to those in favour and in opposition of an application to the district to add another 166 man camp to Chetwynd for a period of up to 3 years. The application was sent in by Dave Milner of Flite Oilfield Services who already has a closed camp for contracted workers in town. Firstly Tasha Sheppard of Pomeroy Inn & Suites took the stand to reiterate her concerns she expressed when the original application was put through. She mentioned that the Pomeroy's occupancy rates have been very low for the past year. Her concerns were echoed by the owner of the Stagecoach hotel who says he is sitting at 8% occupancy, as of now.

Dave took the stand to tell everyone in attendance he is not planning on investing 3 million for this camp unless the need is there. His camp is also slow and currently only sitting at 40% occupancy. He mentioned he was trying to get ahead of the game in the instance that the town begins bursting at the seams like years prior, where people travelling out of town for room and board or sometimes sleeping in their vehicle. Administration was asked about the process to bring this application to council again. Carol Newson replied that if the request was denied he would have to wait at least 6 months to reapply at which time could take up to 2 months after that to go through the public input period again. When it came to the decision, Mayor and Council were split down the middle and ultimately the request was denied.

Prepare popcorn according to package directions. Remove all unpopped kernels. Place popcorn in large bowl; top with oats, cranberries and peanuts.

Combine brown sugar and honey in a medium saucepan. Cook over medium-high heat for 6 minutes or until mixture comes to full boil and sugar is dissolved, stirring occasionally.

Pour syrup over popcorn mixture and toss gently to coat evenly with syrup. Place mixture in pan.

Bake 20 minutes, stirring once midway through baking. Remove from oven; lightly press popcorn mixture evenly in pan. Cool on rack about two hours or until set. Cut in 24 bars. Store in tightly sealed container.

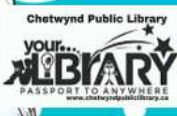
