CODE BLUE BBQ



The Super Valu parking lot felt a police presence on Saturday, thanks to a fundraising BBQ held by the local Code Blue program to help fund their upcoming trip to Surrey. The program began there in 2008, with the Chetwynd chapter representing the first time it has ever been run outside of Surrey. Code Blue is an afterschool fitness program headed by local RCMP Constable Sue Harvey, where officers work with kids to provide life lessons alongside a good workout. The children are run through problem-solving exercises to show how smoothly things can go with coordinated communication. They'll sometimes run firefighter training drills to emphasize partnership and help create a sense of team unity that Harvey says will help them "gain a solid foundation for what they're going to need later in life."

The program runs 1 hour per week from September to May, with the fundraiser allowing them to attend the year-end wrap-up party held in Surrey, featuring a welcoming feast, group run and workout before a celebration ceremony acknowledging all the hard work the kids have put in. Constable Harvey said she wants to see the program expanded and will work with people in Tumbler Ridge, Hudson's Hope and Dawson Creek to try and establish more chapters, with the hope that perhaps Chetwynd can host the finale next year. "It's humbling to me for them to give me that trust and join this program," said Harvey, with the pride she felt in seeing the kids work together and succeed beaming through. She wants to help bring the program to more communities and anyone interested in helping out or donating should get in touch with her at the local RCMP detachment.

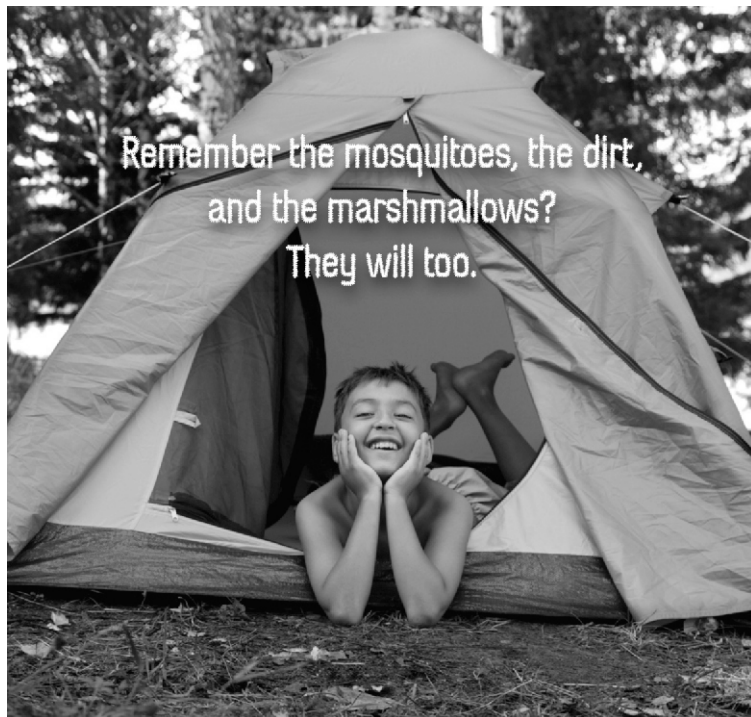

SEED LIBRARY SPROUTS IN CHETWYND

The Chetwynd Public Library held a "Seed Saturday" on April 30th to inaugurate their new seed library, with local gardening aficionados gathering to share gardening tips, techniques and stories. The new library currently features 28 types of seeds, mostly vegetables as well as some flowers, with that number to grow as more seed varieties are collected. The library was made possible by a grant from TD FEF (TD Friends of the Environment Foundation), a program that supports green initiatives in communities across Canada. Students from Little Prairie Elementary assisted in preparing the event, helping to count, label and package the various varieties for people to take home. In return, the library gave them some seeds to use in the school greenhouse, hopefully helping to create another generation of budding gardeners.



The seed library is completely free and anyone can go down, sign up and receive packages of seeds for their home gardens, along with advice and instructions on how to harvest and save seeds for returning to the library. The library is the first of its kind in our section of the Peace, and they hope to encourage even more people to start gardening and share seeds. The more people that join and share seeds, the more diverse the available offerings will be, so they encourage people to stop in and pick up some seeds if they've always suspected they have a green thumb. Coordinator Ana Peasgood was happy about the launch, adding "Gardeners are wonderful for sharing and since we're librarians, it's a great fit." The library will be cataloguing all the various seeds as well as the feedback and results people have gotten from their gardening efforts, and there was a discussion about having a regular meet-up once a month from 1-3 pm on the last Saturday of every month.
