BOB ZIMMER RE-ELECTED IN PRINCE GEORGE-PEACE RIVER-NORTHERN ROCKIES

Conservative candidate and incumbent MP Bob Zimmer was reelected last night in the Prince Geroge-Peace River-Northern Rockies riding, amidst the red tide that has swept the Liberals to power in Ottawa.

Zimmer garnered 53% of the vote in this riding, with a total of 27,236. The Liberals overtook the NDP, with candidate Matt Shaw getting 12,863 votes, NDP candidate Kathi Dickie 8,014 votes, and Green Party candidate Elizabeth Biggar 2,672.

Across the border in the Grande Prairie-Mackenzie riding, the Conservative candidate Chris Warkentin was also reelected with a healthy majority, taking 73% of the popular vote.

The race was much closer south of PG, with Todd Doherty defeating Liberal and NDP candidates Tracy Calogheros and Trent Derrick, taking 36% of the vote to the Liberal's 32% and the NDP's 26%.

Preliminary results by Elections Canada show that nationwide, 17,546,697 voters headed to the polls yesterday, a turnout of 68%. That represents a huge jump from 2011's federal election, which saw a turnout of 14,720,580, or 61.1%.



DIGITAL DISPLAY ON CO ALARMS CAN HELP KEEP YOUR FAMILY SAFE

(NC) Your carbon monoxide alarm is beeping occasionally. You feel no symptoms, and you have determined it's not an emergency. The battery is fresh and the alarm is installed in the correct location. What else could it be trying to tell you?

While alarm manufacturers would have you read your owner's manual (always a good idea) as part of your investigative work, most homeowners likely don't. Fortunately, technology can help.

Some models of CO alarms feature an LED digital display to help you decipher the chirps. If the alarm senses the presence of carbon monoxide, it will sound and a numeric concentration level (measured in parts-permillion) will show. If "lb" shows in the display, the primary or backup battery needs to be changed. And, if "eol" appears, the alarm has reached its end-of-life and needs to be replaced.

In addition to models with a continuous digital display, manufacturer Kidde Canada has new generation "worry-free" products that contain a 10-year sealed battery that never needs to be replaced for the 10-year life of the alarm itself.

"Alarms don't last forever, so replacement is extremely important," says Carol Heller, a home safety specialist with Kidde. "By having the alarm itself remind homeowners that it's time to be replaced, we can help make it easier for families to stay protected."

Heller advises that any CO alarm manufactured prior to 2009 must be replaced.
