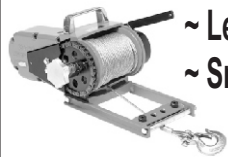

TEMPERATURE RECORDS BROKEN YESTERDAY IN CHETWYND AND DAWSON CREEK

On Wednesday May 23rd the heat in Chetwynd and Dawson Creek broke records.

According to the Environment Canada website, the mercury hit 28.0 degrees Celsius on Wednesday May 23rd at 3 PM in Chetwynd, breaking the previous record of 27.8 degrees set in 2015.

In Dawson Creek, the temperature hit a high of 29.3 degrees, smashing a nearly 50-year-old record of 26.1 degrees set in 1969.

The heat in Fort St. John also broke an old record with the temperature hitting 27.9 degrees. the previous record of 25.6 degrees was set in 1961.

The average high for this time of year in the Peace is around 18 degrees.
