MAYOR COURTOIREILLE MAKES PROCLAMATION

Mayor Courtoreille met with Melyssa Reyland, Surerus and Little Prairie Haven senior's home's manager, this past Friday, to proclaim April 6th 2019 "Caregiving Around the Clock" Family and Community Caregiver Recognition Day.

In 2012, it was estimated that 8 million Canadians, or 28% of the population are family caregivers. Family and Community Caregivers are a vital component of the healthcare team providing care and support to individuals who are frail, elderly, chronically ill or living with disabilities. A large number of them are finding themselves providing care 24 hours a day, for 7 days a week.

Although caregiving can be rewarding, it is not without consequences such as stress, poor health, and a caregiver burnout. Six out of ten caregivers also still juggle everyday tasks such as preparing children for school, managing household responsibilities, and working other part or full time jobs. As a caregiver they have the added responsibility of managing medications for their loved one. Whether it is a senior with Alzheimer's or a child with special needs, the required attention can be non-stop.

Caregiving affects the whole family, mealtimes are extremely important in the caregiver setting. Ensuring that the caregiver and family members get the proper nutrition is important for maintaining strength, energy, stamina, and a positive attitude.

A caregiver taking time for one's self is equally important in protecting and ensuring personal health, strengthening family relationships, preventing burnouts and can enable care recipients to stay at home up to three times longer. Respite gives a chance to take a breather and re-energize in order to be as good a caregiver tomorrow as they were that day.

With the responsibility of family caregivers in our country growing each year, it is even more essential to encourage these heroes to take some time for respite so they may continue their mission of providing that loving care that only they can provide.

Recognition is due to these family and community caregivers for their dedication and commitment to improving the quality of life for their friends and family members, often under conditions which impede their own physical, emotional, and financial health and wellness.

"Family caregivers are unsung heroes". They are mothers, fathers, daughters, sons, and other family members and friends and provide 80% of care in their homes.

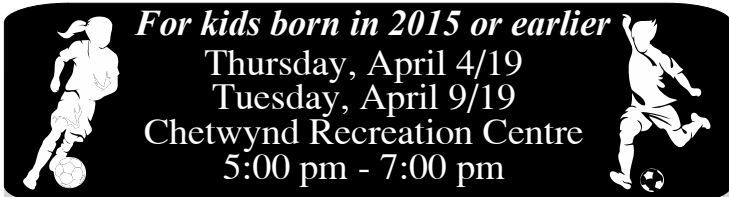
