NEW DETACHMENT COMMANDER AT CHETWYND RCMP

One of her goals is to get Chetwynd RCMP members more involved in the community, not just while on duty, but on their own time as well. "We're trying to get them doing things with community members, because that's what life is, it's getting involved with the community." She says that's probably why she's loved every community she's been in, and why she loves the North so much.

Antonioni-Stevens enjoys hockey, triathlons, fishing, hunting, hiking, quadding and sledding with her husband, 3-year old son, and dog Mikka.

Winter Parking on District Roads Information Everyone Should Know



The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles
No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:

- (i) in violation of this bylaw;
- (ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with firefighting;
- (iii) in a position that causes to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.

The successful contractor shall be available as needed during any snowfall event whenever there is an accumulation of 4" of snow or more during this winter season; and ensure that parking lots are cleaned prior to 8:00 AM local time for every business day (Mon -Thurs 8:00AM-4:30PM and alternate Fridays 8:00AM-2:30PM), and ensure that residential driveways only are cleared.

The WMFN Ranch is responsible for grading the main road (West Moberly Rd.) and access roads (Heritage Rd., Cryingman Rd., Brown Rd., Miksu Rd. and Water Treatment Plant Rd.). The Ranch will communicate with the contractor as to when they are grading so that the contractor can ensure that the driveways are not plowed in and the residents have safe and easy access.

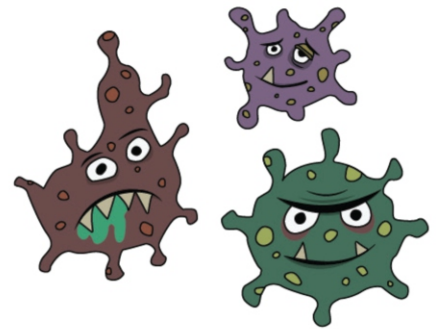

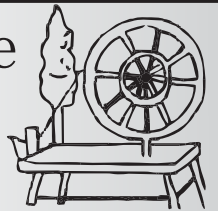
